


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Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of the College's Careers program, Year 10 students have already been provided information and engaged in activities designed to look at career options and subject pathways for their senior education. Students have received a copy of the Senior Subject Guide 2024, which is available on the Emmaus College website under Curriculum>Subject Selection.

As a parent/carer you play an important role in helping your child make educational choices and career decisions, and so we encourage you to read through this Subject Selection Guide with your student. On *Wednesday, 2 August,* Heads of Faculty will be available to answer any questions you may have regarding subjects for 2024. Representatives from tertiary institutions, certificate courses, apprenticeship companies and other pathway options will also be available. Senior Enrolment Interviews

Re-enrolment interviews are compulsory for all students intending to return to Emmaus College in 2024. The interviews take place after school from 3:15 pm – 6:00 pm during Week 9 of this term (Monday, 4 September to Friday, 8 September). Year 10 students and their parents/carers will be required to book an interview via SOBs online; details and a link will be provided closer to the date.

Subject Selection

Students will receive a link via email which will provide access to online subject selection. Online subject selection will open from **Thursday**, **3 August**, and printed receipts and a signed Subject Reflection Form, listing the subjects chosen, are due into the Main Street office by **Monday**, **14 August**.
